Collecting Infants at 2 O' Clock:

Because there are 30 Junior Infant children beginning school in September, we have decided to move both Infants classes to rooms 2 and 3 at the end of the corridor, beside the junior toilets for the coming school year. This will help the teachers to supervise the children more effectively.

Accordingly, we will need to streamline the picking up of children at 2pm. Therefore, the teachers will line up the children before 2pm and walk them down the corridor to the front door. Parents and bus drivers are asked to collect the children at the door at that point.

In the interests of safety and organisation, we ask that children be collected at 2pm. Miss Slattery in particular will have been in charge of 30 children all day, and it is unfair to leave children with her, standing in the corridor while she awaits their collection. Your co-operation in this would be most appreciated.

Those children who travel on the Bus Eireann buses at 3pm will be minded in the classroom by either Miss Watson or Miss Slattery. We thank both teachers for facilitating parents in this regard on a voluntary basis.

Sports Week:

Sports and Activity Week begins on Wednesday 20th June. Sports Day will be Thursday 21st June. The staff has compiled a rota of activities for each afternoon and for all day Thursday.

A list of the items needed for Sports Day and the times when activities are on has been provided to all pupils. **The full timetable of activities for Sports Day is on the Homepage of our website also.** The children can bring in treat foods and drinks to their own liking that day and all the infant children will remain in school until 3 pm on Thursday only, so that they can receive their medals and ice pops.
