School Uniform And Tracksuit

Scoil Nioclás Naofa has a school policy on the wearing of a uniform and tracksuit.

The school uniform consists of a crested royal blue jumper/cardigan, navy trousers/slacks/pinafore and blue collared shirt or blouse. The children are encouraged to wear this uniform on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday each week. The children are encouraged to keep their uniform clean and tidy. Children are asked to wear a navy tie for special occasions and school photographs. Allowances are made when uniforms become wet or dirty and the children have to wear other clothes on these days.

The Parents' Association and Board of Management fully support and endorse our Uniform Policy. In September 2008 our crested uniform was introduced with the assistance of the Parents' Association who researched the entire project and communicated all to the parent body. All classes are encouraged to become familiar with the crest and historical significance of the emblems on it.

Our school tracksuit consists of a plain navy tracksuit with a blue polo shirt underneath. Children are discouraged from wearing gaudy tracksuits with any type of large logo. Some parents have opted for a crested navy tracksuit. Pupils may wear the tracksuit on Thursdays and Fridays as many pupils will be engaged in PE, swimming, drama or educational trips on those days. We encourage all children to keep their clothes clean, tidy and in a wearable condition.

Parents are reminded regularly to mark all belongings clearly for identification purposes.
